Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ,

(my Pastor's page this month is adapted from a study by Dr. Josh Franklin, the Pastor at Mt. Vernon Baptist where my parents attend in Virginia – it is a good word for us to hear!)

Psalm 22:3 says, "But Thou art holy, O Thou that inhabits the praise of Israel." I want you and I to focus on the power of praise this month.

David Jeremiah writes, "Did you know there is someone who really gets bent out of shape whenever you go to church? It truly torments the devil and every one of his 'assistants' when you worship God, in the public sanctuary or the private one. It throws a wrench into the detailed agenda of demonic works. In all the other things we do, there are countless windows of opportunity for the devil to steal in and do his thing. But when you worship God devotedly, Satan is out of his league. He is completely stripped of power, and that's always been the one thing the devil can't handle."

Whenever and wherever God's people praise Him, He reigns among them, He inhibits their praises, Satan is stripped of his power and miraculous things happen on their behalf. Praising God is powerful!

Consider in scripture the countless times God delivered His people after they praised. God delivered Jonah from the fish, after he praised (see Jonah 2:1, 9-10). God delivered Paul and Silas from jail, after they praised! Remember them praying and singing joyfully to God while in chains at midnight in Acts 16:25-26? Then the earthquake came and the chains were loosed! Their praise, led to deliverance and the opportunity to witness and led even the jailer to Christ!

God delivered King Jehoshaphat in 2<sup>nd</sup> Chronicles 20:1-30! He was outnumbered, trapped and by all physical appearances, about to be massacred. But he prayed saying, "God…we are powerless before this great multitude who are coming against us; nor do we know what to do, but our eyes are on you." (v.12) God responded to this prayer assuring Jehoshaphat that the battle was the Lord's and that Jehoshaphat would not need to even fight! Jehosaphat believed God's promise and then responded with praise before God's promise came! He led the army forward into battle but it was not an army of war, but an army of praise! It was a marching band singing praises to God and the scripture tells us that when the praise began, the Lord set ambushes against the enemies of God's people and the enemies actually destroyed one another!

Here's the point: When the Devil attacks you, PRAISE GOD!! Some have said that Satan has an allergic reaction whenever there is true worship. This is an interesting way of visualizing it. When we praise God, Satan breaks out in hives! When we praise Jesus, Satan's throat gets inflamed and closes up – his lies can no longer be voiced in the presence of praise and truth! When we praise the Holy Spirit, Satan flees from the room hacking and sneezing! Missionary Amy Carmichael writes, "I believe truly that Satan cannot endure praise and worship, so he slips out of the room, more or less, when there is a true song."

Are you suffering with depression, moods, or do you feel defeated? TRY PRAISE Do you lack joy, or do you have a problem being positive? TRY PRAISE

Are you going through a deep trial in your family or life? TRY PRAISE

Would you like to have more power in your life? More power in witnessing, serving & teaching? TRY PRAISE

Colossians 3:16 says, "Let the word of Christ richly dwell within you, with all wisdom teaching and admonishing one another with psalms and hymns and spiritual songs, singing with thankfulness in your hearts to God." Let us be His church who relentlessly praises Him! See you on Sundays as we praise our great and awesome God!

Zach Denk called the meeting to order and Pastor Mark led us in prayer.

Minutes from the November 20, 2023 meeting were approved as printed.

**TREASURER'S REPORT**: Received the November & December Summary Reports by Month, the 2023 Summary Report and the Budget Report for 2023.

Finished the year strong. God has been faithful. Transferred \$18,016.00 from savings accounts throughout the year which was deposited in the General Fund to help cover costs of heating oil and the salary for the youth director.

- 4. Pastor Mark will check with the families of children to see if they would be willing to serve as acolytes.
- 5. \$1,5000 was collected through the Christmas Card Post Office which was mailed to the Baca family who has relocated to Arizona to be near family.
- 6. The \$230.00 paid for the bus for Christmas Caroling has been refunded. Christmas Caroling was cancelled due to inclement weather.
- 7. The Nurture Commission has received the year end statement for the youth accounts.
- 8. Planning a "Kid's Fun Day" for Saturday, March 23<sup>rd</sup> from 11:00 4:00 which will be a time for parents to drop off their kids. There will be activities planned for the children. More details to come.
- 9. Thank you to:

  - Deanna Hoffman and Gayle Denk for planning "Carols & Cookies" and to the Bell Choir for their performance.
