Grace and peace to you from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ, Psalm 46:10 says, "BE STILL & KNOW THAT I AM GOD."

"BE STILL..."

Have you done this today? This week? Why is it so hard to stop and be still?

Another way of putting this is "STOP STRIVING". Stop living and depending on your effort. Stop striving in your own power. Stop resisting the call to slow down and know God. Stop fighting against what God is doing in your heart but rather surrender in stillness before Him. Know that He is God. Know that He loves you. Know that He has the greatest plans for you. Know that He is your refuge. So stop striving, but rather rest in Him and in His strength!

Yet another way of phasing this in English which the Hebrew words are meant to capture is "LET GO" or "RELEASE". Let go of your control. Let go of your life. Let go of your burdens and troubles and give them to Him. Let go and release everything to God knowing who He is. Be still and remember that He is your refuge and strength. Let go of your strength and trust in Him. Know that He is God.

Again, slow down and hear the words..."BE STILL"

"BE STILL...& KNOW THAT I AM GOD."

This verse does not tell us to be still for stillness' sake. Remember that it is a focused stillness. You are to be still in order to know that the Lord is God. To focus your heart on Him. To meditate on His nature, His power and His authority. To wonder at His love. To delight in His character. To recenter your life in view of the simplest fact: HE IS GOD. In the stillness, all else becomes irrelevant in the intimate knowledge of who He is! All the problems, all the troubles, all the strivings get swallowed up in His presence. Be still and know Him!

Will you take time daily to BE STILL? Will you take time daily to STOP STRIVING? Will you take time daily to LET GO and RELEASE? Will you take time daily to KNOW THAT HE IS GOD??

This fall, every Sunday morning at 10:30 is a purposeful opportunity for all of us to come together in Christian fellowship and to BE STILL together and know that He is God. Join us!

Thursday night bible studies at 6:00, the Men's group this fall, Sunday school, women's fellowship and more – all of these are times to stop and let go of the busyness of life and to come together in community in order to be still and know that He is God. Join us!

As a church family, let us be still and know that He is God!
